

**AGREEMENT FOR THE INSTITUTION
OF THE INTERNATIONAL CENTRE FOR STUDIES ON HISTORY AND
ARCHAEOLOGY OF THE ADRIATIC
“CISA”**

Preliminary remarks

1. since 2009 an informal collaboration between the above-mentioned subjects has been carried out, aimed at scientific research on the ancient Adriatic starting from the creation of a digital Atlas, entitled "AdriAtlas" (<http://adriaticummare.org/it/>);
2. the École Française de Rome - Institut Ausonius UMR n°5607 already have a close and long-lasting collaboration aimed at scientific research on the ancient Adriatic, with the Research Centre of the Slovenian Academy of Sciences and Arts in Ljubljana; the Archaeological Institute - Academy of Albanological Studies of Tirana; the Juraj Dobrila University of Pula; the University of Bari Aldo Moro; the Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Bologna; the University of Chieti-Pescara; the University of Ferrara; the University of Foggia; the University of Salento; the University of Macerata; the University of Padova; the University of Trieste, the University of Verona; the University of Rijeka, the University of Zadar; this collaboration was strengthened by trilateral agreements among École Française de Rome, the Université de Bordeaux Montaigne - Institut Ausonius and the Universities of Bari, Bologna, Chieti-Pescara, Foggia, Macerata, Padova, Salento and Verona calibrated on the AdriAtlas project;
3. the parties intend to structure, strengthen and develop this common research activity through a unitary and coherent scheduling that can be made possible thanks to the establishment of an "International Centre for Studies on the History and Archaeology of the Adriatic - CISA" (henceforth "Centre");
4. each of the Parties will participate in the Centre on its own behalf and through its research structure,

designating its own scientific referent within such structure that will collaborate on the project:

- the Department of Humanities of the University of Macerata, with its own resolution dated 13 June 2018, expressed interest in joining the aforementioned Centre, appointing Prof. Roberto Perna as its scientific representative;

- the Department of History of the University of Zadar, in compliance with its own regulations, has expressed an interest in joining the aforementioned Centre, appointing Prof. Anamarija Kurilic as its scientific representative;
5. the inter-university and international centres must be constituted pursuant to and by effect of Art. 91 of the Italian Presidential Decree 11 July 1980 n. 382 and the statutory and regulatory provisions in force in each of the aforementioned institutions.

The Preliminary remarks are an integral part of this act.

Art. 1 - Establishment, denomination and composition of the Centre

1. The International Centre called "International Centre for Studies on the History and Archaeology of the Adriatic - CISA" is established among the above-mentioned Parties. The Centre is a body not endowed with legal personality that establishes as its goals the objectives indicated in Art. 3 of the present agreement and is composed of the following Units:

- University of Macerata - Department of Humanities;
- Aix-Marseille Université and CNRS, taking part on their own behalf and on behalf of Centre Camille Jullian - Histoire et Archéologie de la Méditerranée et de l'Afrique;
- University of Bari Aldo Moro - Department of Humanities (DISUM);
- Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Bologna - Department of History Cultures and Civilizations;
- Université de Bordeaux Montaigne and National Centre for Scientific Research (CNRS), taking part on their own behalf and on behalf of AUSONIUS, Research Institute on Antiquity and the Middle Ages (IRAM), mixed research unit (UMR) n ° 5607;
- University of Chieti-Pescara - Department of Psychological, Health and Territory Sciences;
- University of Ferrara - Department of Humanities;
- University of Foggia- Department of Humanities, Letters, Cultural Heritage, Education Sciences;
- Research Centre of the Slovenian Academy of Sciences and Arts at Ljubljana - Institute of Archaeology;
- University of Padova - Department of Cultural Heritage: Archaeology, History of Art, Cinema and Music;
- Juraj Dobrila University of Pula - Centre for Interdisciplinary Research in Landscape Archaeology – Faculty of Humanities;
- University of Rijeka – Department of History, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences;
- École Française de Rome;
- University of Salento - Department of Cultural Heritage;
- Academy of Albanological Studies of Tirana - Archaeological Institute;
- University of Trieste - Department of Humanities;
- University of Verona - Department of Cultures and Civilizations;
- University of Zadar - Department of History.

Art. 2 - Administrative office

1. The Centre has administrative office at the University of Macerata (Department of Humanities). The administrative office can be changed upon the unanimous agreement of the Units members of the Centre.

Art. 3 - Purpose of the Centre

1. The Centre aims at promoting and strengthening historical and archaeological investigations on the Adriatic in ancient times, both nationally and internationally, by developing, supporting and achieving joint research, training, enhancement and management programs and projects related to the specific theme of the "AdriAtlas" project, anchored to a horizon extended from Prehistory to the Early Middle Ages and calibrated also on an open look to the entire Mediterranean basin.

2. In particular, the Centre intends to:

- a) develop scientific research projects on the topics of reference;
- b) take care of the publication of scientific studies in the sector, by fostering an open access approach;
- c) create the digital and geo-localized catalog of the archaeological sites in the Adriatic area;

- d) carry out projects aimed at the enhancement, management and urban and territorial planning of the historical-archaeological heritage of the Adriatic area, with particular attention to the application of ICT;
- e) contribute to the preservation of the historical-archaeological heritage of the Adriatic space through the creation and diffusion of specific researches with reference also to a global approach to landscape archaeology;
- f) develop projects and programs aimed at the development of public archaeology by strengthening the propensity of the individual Units to open up to the socio-economic context, through the exploitation and transfer of knowledge ('third mission and public engagement');
- g) organize seminars, conferences and exhibitions on the topics of reference;
- h) carry out training projects and programs with particular attention to the III level education [PhD, master], to higher education and to lifelong learning;
- i) participate in national and international calls and research projects, only through the partner Universities, Centres, and Research Institutes and in relation to the actual contribution that each Unit will make available for the projects.

Art. 4 - Participation in the activities of the Centre

1. The activities of the Centre may be participated by professors and researchers belonging to the aforementioned Universities and Research Centres and Institutes, or affiliated with them for at least five years, who carry out scientific research in the areas of interest of the Centre, upon admission request submitted to the Director and forwarded by him to the Council that decides on acceptance.
2. Research fellows, grant holders or contractors of the Universities and Research Centres and Institutes or, on the basis of specific agreements, of Italian and foreign public and private Bodies and Centres, may collaborate in the activities of the Centre.

Art. 5 - Organs of the Centre

1. The organs of the Centre are:
 - a) the Director;
 - b) the Council.

Art. 6 - Director

1. The Director of the Centre is the scientific representative of one of the Units, elected by simple majority among the members of the Council; (s)he is appointed by decree of the legal representative of the Institution in which the Centre has its administrative office, (s)he holds office for three years and can be confirmed only once.
2. The Director has the following functions:
 - a) coordinates and promotes the activities of the Centre;
 - b) at the end of the financial year prepares a report on the activities carried out by the Centre and on the expenses incurred.
3. In case of absence or temporary unavailability of the Director, his/her duties are performed by the Deputy Director, appointed by the Director at the time of his/her appointment.

Art. 7 - Council

1. The Council consists of:
 - a) a scientific representative for each Department, Centre and Institute (Research Unit) members of the Centre, appointed by the competent bodies of the Universities and the Research Centres and Institutes themselves;
 - b) Italian or foreign experts of high scientific qualification, specialized in the activities included in the Centre's programs, chosen by the Council, in a number not higher than that of the Units belonging to the Centre.
2. The Council is appointed by decree of the legal representative of the Institution where the Centre has its administrative office, and remains in office for the duration of the agreement.
3. The Council is convened by the Director. For the validity of the meetings it is necessary the presence of at least half plus one of its components; the justified absentees are excluded from the calculation. The decisions are taken by the majority of the votes cast, except for decisions relating to the purposes referred to in

paragraphs b) and c) of Art. 3 of the present agreement which require, to be approved, a vote by a majority of two thirds of the votes cast.

4. The Council:

- a) elects the Director among its members;
- b) deliberates on applications for membership of the Centre pursuant to Art. 8 and on the proposals of exclusion pursuant to Art. 15 paragraph 2 of the present agreement;
- c) approves the co-optation of highly qualified Italian or foreign experts, as members of the Council itself, according to the modalities set forth in Art. 7 paragraph 1.b) of the present agreement;
- d) deliberates on applications for participation in the Centre's activities pursuant to Art. 4 paragraph 1 of this agreement;
- e) deliberates on the proposals of the Centre's activities and on collaborations with other bodies;
- f) proposes any amendments to the present agreement establishing the Centre;
- g) manages any funds of the Centre; approves the budget estimate of income and expenditure for the relevant financial year and the report on the activities carried out in the previous year, prepared by the Director pursuant to Art. 6, to be submitted to ratification by the competent body of the Institution where the Centre has its administrative office;
- h) deliberates on any other subject submitted by the Director for examination.

The resolutions referred to in paragraphs b) and c) must be approved by at least two thirds of the votes cast.

5. The Council is convened at least once a year for the approval of the Centre's program of activities; it is also convened whenever the Director deems it necessary or when required by a third of its members.

Art. 8 - Membership of other universities

1. Italian and foreign Universities and Research Institutes and other Institutions can join the Centre, following a Council resolution approved with at least two thirds of the votes cast. The new adhesions are formalized by means of appropriate additional acts to this agreement.

Art. 9 - Collaborations with other bodies

1. For carrying out its tasks, the Centre may establish forms of collaboration with public or private bodies, Italian or foreign, for the deepening of research topics or for the resolution of issues in the relevant scientific areas.

2. The Centre also intends to encourage collaborations in the implementation of the European Union strategy for the Adriatic-Ionian region in connection with other networks of Universities and institutions.

Art. 10 - Financing and administrative management

1. The Centre operates through funding that may come:

- a) from any contribution assigned by the Units participating in the Centre, quantified by the individual Institutions;
- b) from funds possibly conferred by the participating Institutions relating to contracts and agreements with public and private bodies, research funding from national and international competitive tenders, and donations;
- c) from funds from public or private bodies destined exclusively to the Centre's activities;
- d) from any donation and liberality;
- e) from contributions from the Italian Ministry of Education University and Research, from other Ministries, from the Italian National Research Council, from public and private bodies, from the European Union.

2. The Parties constituting - or subsequently joining - the Centre undertake to contribute exclusively in scientific terms to the Centre's activities by supporting specific projects. Any financial contributions must be approved by the competent organs of the Parties.

3. The funds are assigned to the Institution where the Centre has its administrative office, with destination restriction to the same Centre.

4. The administrative and accounting management of the Centre is carried out according to the provisions of the regulations for administration, finance and accounting in force at the Institution where the Centre is based; the administrative and technical staff in force at the administrative office of the Centre provides for this task.

5. Unless otherwise agreed by the Parties, the durable equipment that may be purchased by the Centre is entered in the inventory register of the Institution where the Centre is based.
The Centre will be able to receive free loan assets, through the participating Units, also from third parties, in compliance with current regulations.

Art.11 - Communication of information, privacy and publications

1. Members undertake to exchange information necessary for the implementation of this agreement in accordance with the conditions and commitments established with third parties.

The Parties undertake not to disclose or communicate to third parties the pieces of information that have been defined as confidential by the Proprietary Party and in this case they undertake to:

- distribute them only to authorized staff members and use them only in the context of this agreement,
- not to disclose them directly or indirectly to third parties or to all those who are not party to the agreement without the written consent of the Proprietary Party,
- not to copy, reproduce or duplicate them, totally or partially, without the prior written authorization of the Proprietary Party.

These obligations cease to be applied to the pieces of information that are in the public domain, are already in possession or communicated to the receiving Party by third parties.

It is expressly agreed that the disclosure of information among members under this agreement cannot in any way be interpreted in the sense of conferring, expressly or implicitly, to the receiving Party any right whatsoever on the matters, interventions or discoveries to which such information refers.

2. The publications and communications produced in connection with the Centre's common activities should contain express reference to the scientific link with the Centre.

During the life of the Centre and in the following two years, each member undertakes to present to the Council any dissemination project for publications of the Centre's work to obtain the approval of the other members of the Centre. If the proposal is not answered within thirty (30) days after the draft publication and presentation are sent, the proposal is considered as approved.

The provisions of this article do not constitute an obstacle to the obligation of the researchers involved to produce an annual report on their research activities for the institution they belong to, as this is an internal communication and does not fall within the provisions regulating intellectual property.

Art.12 - Property, protection and use of results

1. The "results" of the Centre are all the knowledge related to the activities carried out, susceptible or not to be protected by intellectual property, including databases, any software and know-how.

2. The results deriving from the activity of the Centre belong in co-ownership to members who have contributed to achieving them, in relation (pro rata) to their intellectual, material and financial contribution. The terms of enjoyment of the results will be regulated by a special agreement between the partners.

3. Each member retains exclusive ownership of the results not deriving from the activity of the Centre, whether they are patented or not, as well as of knowledge and intellectual and/or industrial property rights developed or acquired prior to the entry into force of this agreement or independently from it.

4. Without prejudice to the rights of third parties, each of the members of the Centre has the non-exclusive right to use the results, patented or not, referred to in the previous paragraph necessary for the realization of the Centre's purposes.

5. The Parties that own the results of the research of the Centre undertake to make them available to members who have not contributed to their achievement, who can use them freely for their research needs, with the exclusion of exploitation for commercial purposes.

Art.13 - Responsibility

1. Each member of the Centre retains ownership of the materials and equipment made available to the other Parties within the scope of this agreement.

2. Each member is responsible for any damage suffered by the equipment he owns during the execution of this agreement, except for a serious or intentional error.

3. Each member is responsible for any damage that may be caused to third parties within the activities related to the Centre.

4. The Centre neither assumes obligations on behalf of individual participants nor represents any individual participant, by acting on its behalf. The Centre's participants do not assume the obligations of the Centre nor can they assume obligations on behalf of the Centre. Any guarantee by the participating institutions on loans contracted by the Centre is excluded.

5. The Centre cannot contract mortgages or loans directly.

Art. 14 - Duration

1. The Centre shall have a duration of five years, without prejudice to the possibility of early termination on the proposal of the Council. The agreement establishing the Centre is subject to approval by the competent bodies of the member institutions and comes into force from the date of the last signature. It is renewable for an equal period, subject to written agreement between the Parties approved by the competent bodies.

Art. 15 - Withdrawal - Exclusion

1. Withdrawal by each member is allowed, subject to written cancellation to be sent to the Director of the Centre, by certified e-mail or registered letter with return receipt, at least three months before the effective withdrawal.

The notice of withdrawal of a member does not exempt it from respecting the terms of the present agreement until the date of effective withdrawal.

2. The Council may decide to exclude one of the members in the event of a serious breach of one of the terms of the agreement and shall communicate it to the party by registered letter stating the reason for the exclusion with at least one month's notice. The exclusion must be voted by the Council by absolute majority, after discussion with the interested party, which does not take part in the vote.

Art. 16 - Termination of the Centre

1. In addition to the provisions of Art. 15 paragraph 1, the early termination of the Centre is decided unanimously by the Council, subject to convening on a specific agenda.

Art. 17 - Amendments to the agreement

1. The present agreement may be amended on the proposal of the Council of the Centre and with the consequent approval of the academic bodies of the contracting Institutions, which approve the amendments according to the respective statutory and regulatory provisions, in compliance with the regulations concerning the Inter-university Centres.

Art. 18 - Disputes

1. The Parties agree to settle amicably any dispute that may arise from this agreement; in the event that it is not possible to settle it in this way, it is agreed that it will be brought before the competent court of the place where the Centre is based at the time of the dispute.

Art. 19 - Registration and stamp duty

1. The present agreement is subject to registration in the event of use; the costs of any registration are charged to the requesting Party.
